Being a mentor on the Turps Offsite-programme is all about visiting painters in their own studios - whether that's a fully functioning designated space at home or a reclaimed spare room, a purpose-built prefab in the garden or a walled-off space in a multi occupancy studio complex.

The delight in doing these visits comes from the variety and differences in artists' spaces.

Their studios range from the beautifully neat and tidy where there's a place for everything, to the gloriously chaotic. Often every square inch of space is piled high with source material, photos, sketches, and anything to hand becomes a palette. There's a plethora of stuff and things that a painter will collect and deem useful. In all these variations of the studio, their paintings have been made and thought about, ideas and methods are questioned and answered, paintings have been declared finished or are in the process of being so, or maybe discarded and then, later, re-worked.

So, it's an important occasion when as a result of all this effort and making, the paintings are then removed from their origins and placed in a gallery space alongside others' work. It's here that they're exposed to the outside world for consideration by the gallery visitor. They exist in a new space which allows each work to begin to operate on us, on its own terms.












Untitled, Mixed media on paper, aprox. 200x100cm, 2021 Opposite Page: Untitled, iPad drawing, 210x297mm, 2021














